Invitation to Participate in the Anabaptist Community Bible

<u>at FIVE HUNDRED</u> As the Anabaptist movement approaches its 500<sup>th</sup> Anniversary in 2025, MennoMedia is commemorating the event with the

Anabaptist Community Bible, which will feature marginal notes & commentary from 500 Bible study groups from a wide spectrum of Anabaptist faith communities - the aim of which is to inspire Christians to a fresh engagement with Scripture, renewed faith in Jesus, stronger faith communities, and a more vibrant witness in the world.

Our S.C.C. leadership has elected to become 1 of those 500 Bible study groups and welcomes all who wish to participate in the studies to gather at 1:00pm on the following four Sundays: Apr. 16, Apr. 23, May 21 and May 28. After an orientation (Apr 16) the following Sundays will be devoted to three texts: 2 Kings 24:8-25,30; Romans 6:1-14, and Psalm 31:1-8.
